## **Fear your partner is net sicko?**

CHILD protection expert Mark Williams Thomas has this advice on what to do if you suspect YOUR partner is a paedophile:

"First, I suggest confronting them and gauging his or her reaction.

"If you do not feel comfortable talking to your partner, try checking the internet history on their computer, which will show recently visited websites.

"Don't worry if you lack computer knowledge. Call the police or The Child Exploitation and Online Protection Centre (CEOP).

"They will put you in touch with a trained specialist on your local police force.

"Experts will ask you for any internet and email account details you know.

"They will be able to monitor your partner's internet activity.

"If you are extremely worried, choose a time when your partner is out, and take the computer to the police.

"Although what Cheryl Roberts did was extremely courageous, I wouldn't recommend putting yourself at risk like that.

"Most paedophiles are fairly placid, but some have a tendency to violence."
